Project

Conservation Works to a listed farm house.

The brief

To renovate and conserve an existing farm house and barn utilising traditional and modern conservation techniques.

The works include

- Partial roof structure replacement with oak rafters and purlins.
- Replacement roof coverings with existing tiles bedded in lime mortar on oak riven laths.
- Structural repairs to the existing oak beams using a resin and dowel system cast in-situ.
- Extensive joinery repairs using an approved heritage resin repair system.
- New stone parapets and localised stone coin placement.
- Complete repointing and lime render.
- Lime washed and decorated using heritage paints.
